-Student services coordinator for the division monitors great beginnings and oversees all the special education needs.

-Grant through Jordens principal \$745000 for the division.

-Each school was allocated \$1500 for parent sessions and \$500 for student sessions. This is to bring in something to address mental health needs.

-Grade 12 student engagement. These kids were asked questions in grade 9 about what they expect to see in high school, how the division can help them succeed. These students said that high school success coaches

were very helpful. Most students were very supportive of the teachers and felt it was reciprocal and placed very high value on peer relationships.

Negatives: lack of field trips in high school, lack of activities and events to boost morale.
